

#### **Cancellation Due to Weather**

#### Registration/Medical Release

Forms must be filled out and turned into the Awana office as soon as possible. This form also lets us know of any allergies or health issues we need to be aware of, in case of emergency. It is very important that we have this information on fie with your signature on the form. This is for you child's safety!

#### **Club Uniform**

Once your clubber has earned their uniform, they are required to wear each night. They will only be able to receive their awards if they are wearing their club uniform. This also includes special functions such as the Awana banquet.

#### **Discipline**

- **5 Count:** This is used throughout the night to get the clubbers attention and to get them quiet to listen to further instructions During game time, bonus points are sometimes awarded to th team that is lined up and quiet first.
- **3 Count:** This is an individual discipline action. When a clubber is uncooperative or disturbing the rest of the group with noise or actions they are given a 1 count.

If the behavior continues after the first warning they are given a 2 count and will need to speak with the commander.

If that doesn't stop the unwanted behavior they are given a 3 count and a parent or guardian will be called to come and pick up that child and speak with the commander.

#### **Weekly Assignments**

One of the goals of Awana is to store God's Word in the children's heart. Your child is highly encouraged to work weekly on their memory verses. Practicing our loud with you as a parent will be a great help and benefit to your child as they seek to complete their books. Each clubber is encouraged to prepare and compete at least one section per week. The clubber will recite memory verses aloud to a leader during handbook time to receive credit for the work completed.
